## Cutting Directions

**Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches.** Borders are cut to exact length required plus 1/4" seam allowance. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42" wide).

**Fabric A** Cut (1) 4 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (8) 4 7/8" squares.

**Fabric B** Cut (1) 4 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (8) 4 7/8" squares.

**Fabric C** Cut (1) 4 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (8) 4 7/8" squares.

**Fabric D** Cut (1) 4 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (8) 4 7/8" squares.

**Fabric E** Cut (2) 4 7/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strip into (9) 4 7/8" squares.

**Fabric F** Cut (2) 4 7/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strip into (9) 4 7/8" squares.

**Fabric G** Cut (2) 4 7/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strip into (9) 4 7/8" squares.

**Fabric H** Cut (1) 4 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (8) 4 7/8" squares.

**Fabric I** Cut (1) 4 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (8) 4 7/8" squares.

**Fabric J** Cut (1) 4 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (8) 4 7/8" squares.

**Fabric K** Cut (1) 4 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (8) 4 7/8" squares.

**Fabric L** Cut (1) 4 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (8) 4 7/8" squares.

**Fabric M** Cut (13) 4 7/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strip into (99) 4 7/8" squares.

**Binding** Cut (6) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

**Backing** Cut (2) 60" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to make (1) 60" x 68" backing.

## Making the Quilt

### 1. Block Assembly

Place (1) 4 7/8" Fabric A square on top of (1) 4 7/8" Fabric M square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Diagram 1). Sew 1/4" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 1). Cut the two squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 2) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure 4 1/2" square to make (2) Unit 1 squares (Diagram 3).

2. Repeat Step 1 to make (16) Unit 1 squares total.

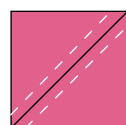

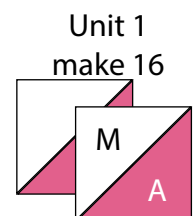

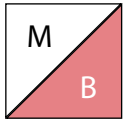

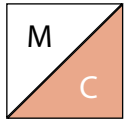

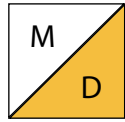

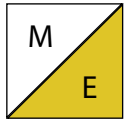

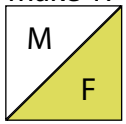

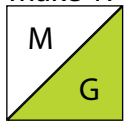

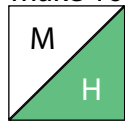

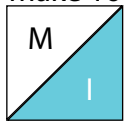

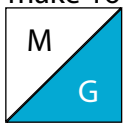

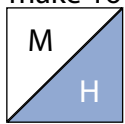

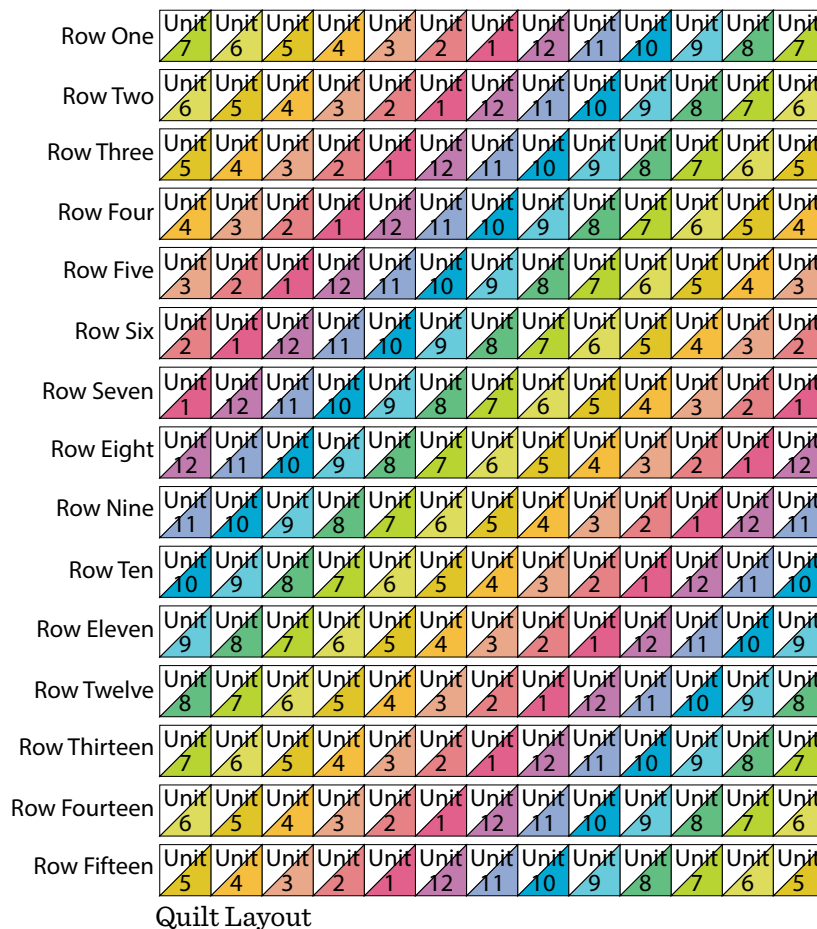
## Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the *Quilt Layout* when assembling the quilt top.)

- Follow the Quilt Layout for unit placement to sew together (13) assorted units to make (1) Row One. Repeat to make Row Two through Row Fifteen.
- Sew the (15) Rows together, in numerical order from top to bottom, to make the quilt top.

## Finishing the Quilt

- Layer and quilt as desired.
- Sew the (6) binding strips together, end to end with a 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- Bind as desired.

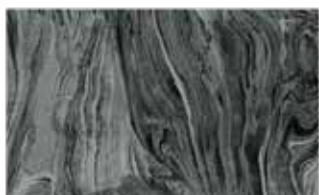

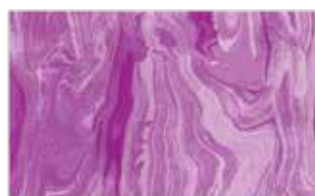
